

Introducing Peter Rabbit[™]: Tales on the Tyne

What is Peter Rabbit[™]: Tales on the Tyne?

It's a large-scale public art trail, following in the footsteps of Great North Snowdogs, Elmer's Great North Parade and Shaun on the Tyne. Presented by St Oswald's Hospice in partnership with Wild in Art and The World of Peter RabbitTM, the event celebrates the North East's creativity, culture, and heritage.

The project aims to:

- Provide a free, city-wide art trail in Newcastle and North Tyneside
- · Highlight local artists and communities
- · Boost tourism, footfall, and spending
- · Deliver educational programmes through art
- Raise awareness of and funds for St Oswald's Hospice

- After the trail ends, it will leave a lasting legacy as each Peter Rabbit will be auctioned to raise funds for St Oswald's Hospice

March 2026 Artist's designs are presented to sponsors to select at an Artist and Sponsor Matching Event.

April – May 2026 Sculptures are painted by artists.

July – Sept

October
Last chance to visit the rabbits at a Farewell Weekend at Newcastle Civic Centre.

October Sculptures sold at auction to raise funds for St Oswald's Hospice.
